

MSc in Physics for Technology (Coursework): Tuition Fees Structure

August 2023 Intake (AY23/24)

For August 2023 intake (AY2023/2024), NUS will provide all Singapore Citizen / Singapore Permanent Resident students with **15%** tuition fee rebate for courses that are not covered by government subsidy in the MPT programme. This rebate will be automatically extended, and alumni need not apply for it.

- ❖ Acceptance Fee: S\$5,450
- ❖ Full-time and part-time Singapore Citizen / Singapore Permanent Resident students will be billed based on the number of courses read per semester (pay by per-course fee). The per-course fees are as follows:

- ❖ Singapore Citizen / Singapore Permanent Resident students who are enrolled to the SSG-funded courses that are skills-based and industry-relevant may be eligible to receive 70% subsidy.

Note:

- The fees listed are in Singapore Dollars (SGD). Amount is subject to the prevailing Goods and Services Tax (GST) rate.
- Fees paid are non-refundable or transferrable in the event of withdrawal of offer made, non-completion of the programme or switching to other coursework programme by the students.
- Students who wish to read more than 40 units or who failed a course and need to repeat / replace a course will be required to pay additional course fee (pay by per-course fee).
